- Created and maintained by the APA (American Psychological Association)
 - Psychology and related disciplines (medicine, psychiatry, nursing, education, etc.)
 - Comprehensive bibliographic database containing more than 5.1M records (journal records from 50+ countries, 29 languages) and updated twice weekly
- Main Contents
 - Academic Journals (2,250+) ...over 80%
 - English records (title, abstract, keywords) from 1806
 - Non-English titles included after 1978
 - 1,500+ journals cover-to-cover (99% peer-reviewed)

Abstract: Cognitive deficits are a core feature of **schizophrenia**. There is ongoing debate on whether cognition is affected by antipsychotic drugs (APDs). This study examined the effect of long-term **treatment** with APDs on cognition in **schizophrenia**. Cognitive function was assessed in 418 patients with **schizophrenia** on long-term **treatment** with APDs (215 on clozapine, 91 on **risperidone** and 112 on typical APDs) and 159 healthy controls using the Repeatable Battery for the Assessment of Neuropsychological Status (RBANS). **Schizophrenia** symptomatology was assessed using the Positive and Negative Syndrome Scale (PANSS). We found that cognitive test scores were significantly lower in all patients compared with the healthy controls on almost all of the total and subscores of RBANS (all $P < 0.001$), except for the visuospatial/constructional index. Individuals taking clozapine showed worse immediate and delayed memory performance than those taking typical APDs (all $P < 0.01$). Moreover, individuals taking clozapine showed better language performance than those taking **risperidone** ($P < 0.01$). Immediate memory and delayed memory were modestly correlated with the types of APDs and the PANSS negative symptomatology. Clozapine performed worse in immediate and delayed memory tests, but exemplified better language performance than risperidone. (PsycINFO Database Record (c) 2015 APA, all rights reserved)

- Define your query with care
- Use Advanced Search to find precise results
- Structure your search – combine with boolians AND , OR, NOT
- Search Keywords and Map to your thesaurus
- Truncate your root words to find more results \$\$\$*****
- More results are better, you can always limit at the end and alter your search

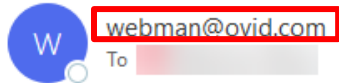
