

- Created between 1991 and 1996 by *NHS* and the *Royal College of Nursing*, launched in Jan 1997, acquired by ProQuest in 2011



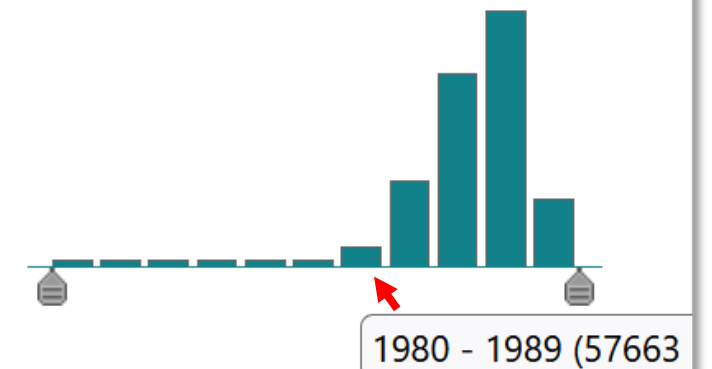

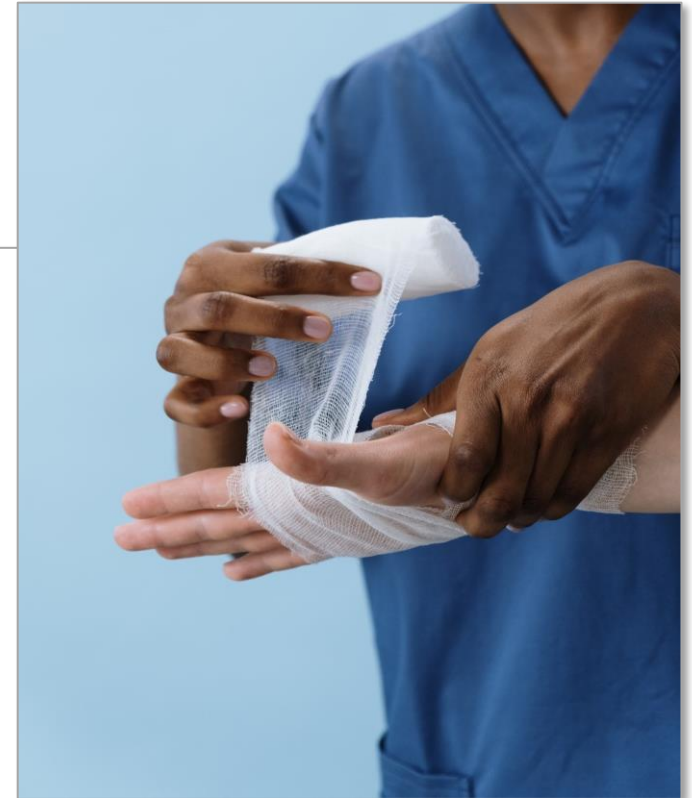

# BND Indexing

## British Nursing Database: Menu of searchable fields

**ABSTRACT** is the formal Abstract of scholarly sources;  
**SUMMARY** includes also the informal top paragraph in sources such Magazines or Reports

The **SUBJECT/SU** field searches both the controlled terms from a Thesaurus (indexed in **MAINSUBJECT**) + Keywords/Identifiers usually provided by the Authors (in the **IF** field – not shown in the menu)

Because BNI contains also Full-Text sources, these are fields for searching, or NOT searching the Full-Text.

**Please note:** the short field labels (TI, AU, AB, PUB, SU, etc) still work along with the full word labels
