August 2023 - Search Syntax Change – “Set” Searching

The **multi-set search syntax**, which allows users to reference an earlier search in their search history without retyping, **has been changed**.

This syntax was problematic for a number of searches trying to find things like chemical names, company names, and similar where the **S#** term might appear.

The **new syntax encloses the “set” reference in square brackets** to allow the syntax to disambiguate between a deliberate search term and reference to a previous query:

(S2 AND S4) NOT S8

(S3 AND S7) NOT “oncology”



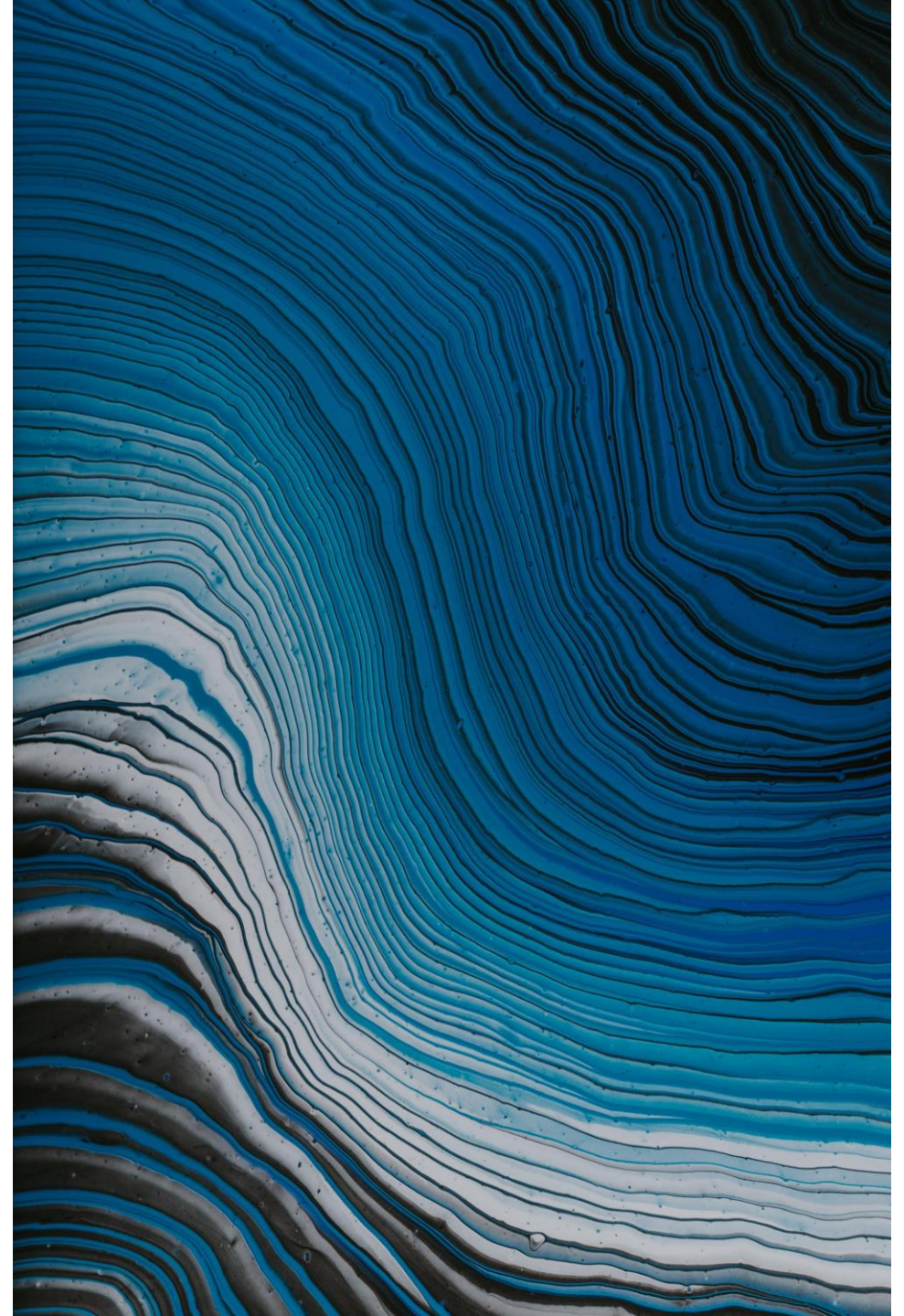


